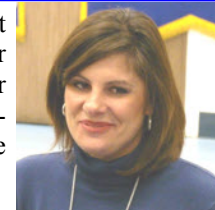

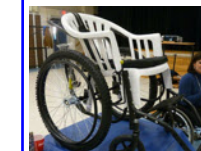
◆ SATURDAY'S PROGRAM ◆

The Free Wheelchair Mission is an international non profit organization dedicated to providing wheelchairs for the impoverished disabled in developing nations.

They have distributed more than 400,000 wheelchairs to more than 70 countries.



The chair is made from a resin lawn chair and a custom steel frame all tucked into a sturdy pair of mountain bike tires.

Each chair costs \$59.20 to manufacture and deliver to the recipient.
