### Fundraising Update

Our 2 major fundraisers this year were the See's Candy holiday sales, and the Crab and Shrimp Feed. While the final numbers from the Crab and Shrimp Feed are still pending some additional numbers from the 20/30 club (who partnered with us on the event), it is likely we will have a budget shortfall of several thousand dollars.

On a brighter note, we have an opportunity to raise additional funds by selling coupons for the Macy's Shopping Day to be held on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Bev Snow has the coupons. We sell them for \$10 each, and the club keeps the revenue. It is Macy's way of supporting non-profit orgs like ours. When shoppers take their coupon to Macy's, they receive \$10 off their purchase, so the ticket costs them nothing. They also receive 10-20% off other purchases that day. There is an ENTER TO WIN part of the card that they drop in a box on the way into Macy's. **Here's the best part.
