Joe Gorman, Supervisor Health & Physical Education Waterbury Board of Education, presented a great deal of information regarding Physical Education in Waterbury. He said that kids are worse off today due to obesity and other issues. With new systems, the 54 staff members are better able to collaborate on lesson plans. Scoliosis and PE testing are done on an annual basis. New computer systems provide information on individual fitness as well as by school, age, and sex and help students improve on fitness tests and their own physical fitness. This has been successful as forty two percent (42%) passed the fitness test in 2009 compared to thirteen percent (13%) who passed in 2004. Waterbury is not suffering as badly as most of the rest of the state regarding Physical Education. Waterbury has one (1) teacher for each school for health and fitness. Information regarding each student is able to be transferred to the new school when the student changes schools.
