Dale "Mad Dog" Messmer gave a powerful speech on the consequences of his choices. He speaks primarily to Junior and Senior High School students. 22 of every 100 children born will not make it to graduation. On average 138 14-18 year olds will die in each 24 hour period. He explained how he grew up in Kansas, served in the U. S. Marine Corps and operated several businesses before becoming involved in drug smuggling. He spent over ten (10) years in jail. He now speaks to youth groups about how one choice can change your life and those around you - family and friends.
