Harvey Burnett introduced Dr. Ann Manley and Cathleen Rafferty from the Dr. Phillips Center for Children and Families. Dr. Manley is a child advocate, recognized twice for her dedication. She's been involved with the Dr. Phillips Center for Children and Families for a decade.

Prior to the creation of the center, abused children had to 'tell their story' over and over to police, investigators, prosecutors, and the person who initially received the report about abuse. The process was difficult and a support system was virtually non-existent. Today, the Dr. Phillips Center for Children and Families advocates for – and responds to – the needs of children in Central Florida who have medical, emotional and developmental challenges, especially those related to child abuse.
