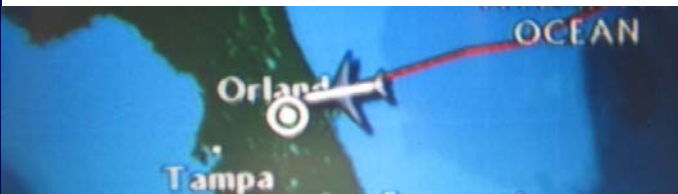


Upcoming Service Project
