## Program Notes

Harry Barley, executive director of METROPLAN ORLANDO, the regional transportation planning agency in Central Florida, spoke about upcoming growth in Central Florida and the future role of transit.

Our traffic issues are generally caused by population growth and prosperity. In the 50's the population was right around 400,000. Today, 3 million people call Central Florida home. That number is expected to double in the coming decades.

Harry spoke about a 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan, which focuses less on a highway oriented system (98% now) and more on a transit oriented system (2% now). A big part of the plan involves Smart Growth, which Harry described as a popular planning concept. SunRail, a commuter rail system, and high speed rail, which will connect Orlando to Tampa and beyond, are a big part of our future transportation system.
