Lynn F called the meeting to order & said due to the ice, we would just have a very casual meeting with an open mike for announcements. Members were invited to stay as long as they wanted but our program, the WHS Key Clubbers were not able to attend. They will be invited to present their program again soon.

Bob Bro reported the rescheduled Farm City Week will be 2/10/10. A sign-up sheet went around. Please sign-up if you can attend and also sign-up all the guests that you want to bring. Please indicate if you and your guests want to eat the lamb meal that is being prepared by Monika Sudakov of The Chestnut Street Inn in Sheffield. We will have an optional meal.

Paul D talked about the 990 forms that go into the Fed and State this time every year. He tries each year to share this information with the Club. All of us as members can look at the budget. In 2009 our Kiwanis Club generated \$56,953 in total revenue. Our fundraising activities resulted in \$38,044 gross income less \$11,737 in expenses or \$26,307 net. This includes our membership dues and payments for the meals. Other income included \$272 in interest income and \$1,550 in advertising income. In total \$21,019 in grants was given out to 32 folks. Expenses included rent at \$1,930, printing and postage costs for \$1,032 which is much lower than it used to be before we emailed newsletters, and other expenses of \$25,120 so our expenses totaled \$49,101. All in all we netted a budget surplus of \$7,852. (Paul, I hope I got this correct!-ed.)
