It is estimated that this spared more than 2.5 million children the effects of IDD. Among the countries who have been aided in their efforts are Albania, Bhutan, Ghana, Madagascar, Nepal, Pakistan, and Zambia. Annual per capita income in these countries range from \$200 to \$400.
