**TONIGHT'S PROGRAM:** Jennifer Schugam - a graduate with a master's degree in Social Work from the University of Maryland at Baltimore, is a licensed graduate social worker and has worked as a mobile mental health clinician in Baltimore County for seven years. Through this position she provides weekly, in-home clinical mental health services for the chronically mentally ill clients. In addition she has another program, Feeding the People, whose mission is to develop and implement a research-based model of nutrition-related in-home care for under-served, low-income diabetics in order to reduce the incidence of diabetes and diabetes related illnesses in Maryland. Feeding the People provides home-delivered meals, nutrition education, and intensive, ongoing support for low-income diabetics in the Baltimore area.

### **MARK YOUR CALENDAR – AUGUST 17.**

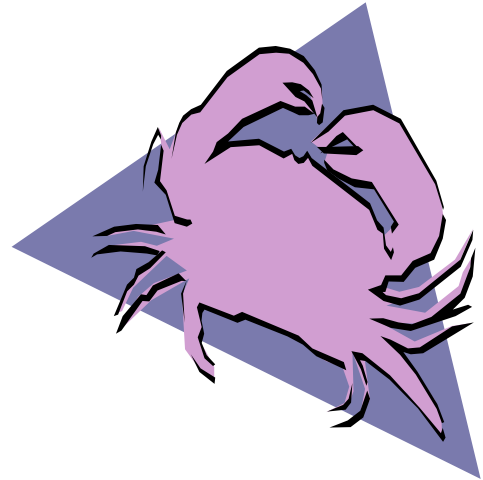
