Through this position she provides weekly, in-home clinical mental health services for the chronically mentally ill clients. In addition she has another program, Feeding the People, whose mission is to develop and implement a research-based model of nutrition-related in-home care for under-served, low-income diabetics in order to reduce the incidence of diabetes and diabetes related illnesses in Maryland. Feeding the People provides home-delivered meals, nutrition education, and intensive, ongoing support for low-income diabetics in the Baltimore area.



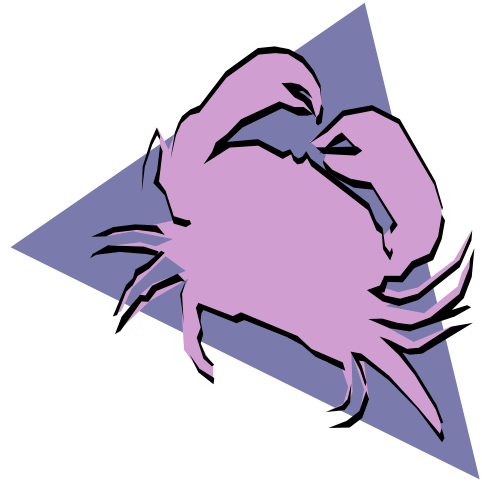
MARK YOUR CALENDAR – AUGUST 17.
