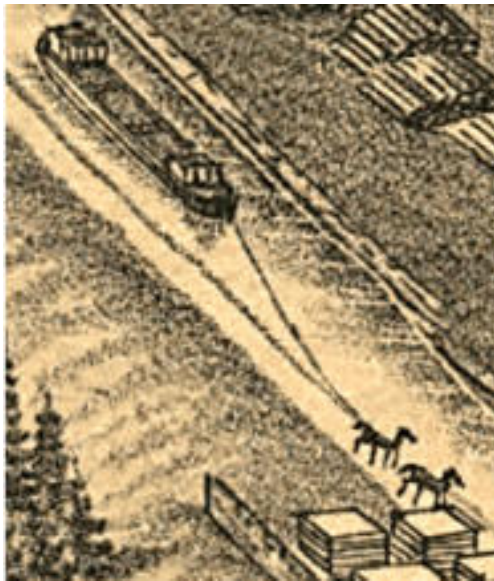

## Guest Speaker Jeanne Williams



Feeder Canal Alliance Executive Director, Jeanne Williams, gave us a brief history on the Feeder Canal and the continuous efforts to preserve it. The canal was built in the early 1800's and was home to several lumber companies. Many businesses and individuals attributed their success to the prosperity the Feeder Canal brought to our region. By the 1920's, the canal was abandoned. Efforts began in 1987 to restore the canal and its trails so that members of our communities could enjoy its many resources. Grant funding alone cannot sustain the continued efforts of the organization, so membership, donations, fundraisers, and volunteers are key to keeping the restoration alive. In June of 2009, the United States Secretary of the Interior, Ken Salazar and the National Park Service announced that the Feeder Canal Towpath Trail is officially designated a **National Recreational Trail!**
