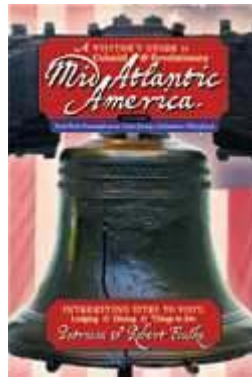
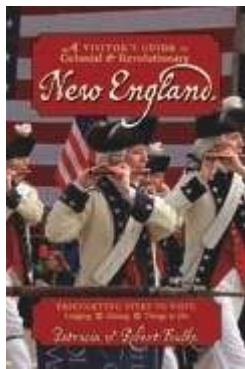
Don's Dealings
