Joslyn Johnson's ad in the Chronicle for celebrating 5 years in business netted her four new accounts!

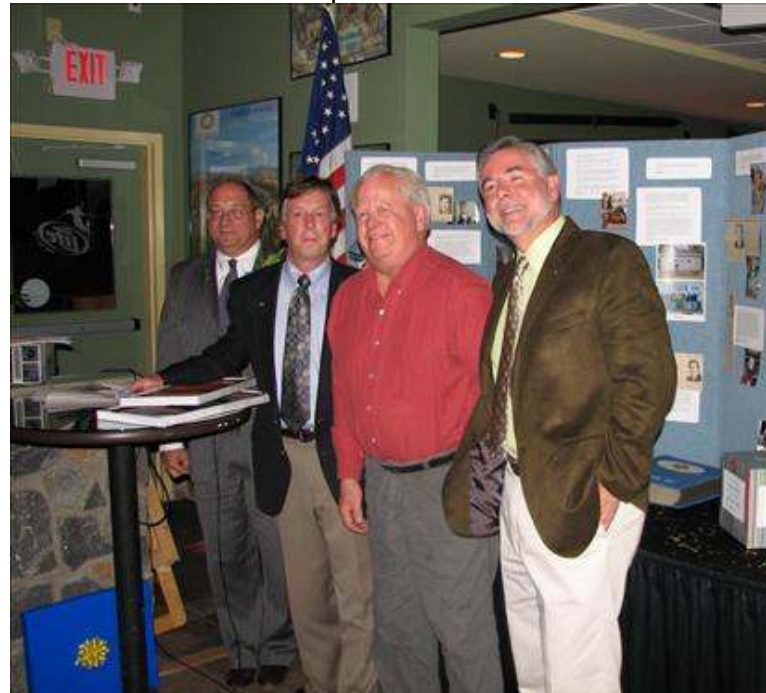
Dave Little recently welcomed his 14th grandchild!
