Licking County Counts

**“The 2010 Census is in our hands.”** That is the message that members of the Licking County Complete Count (Census) Committee, Matthew Hill and Tim Bubb, left with us today. The Federal, State and Licking County Governments have done a lot of preparation for this critical census which is done only once every 10 years. But all the work they have done to have each of us

counted will be in vain if we don't complete and return the simple one page, 10 question census form—and we will suffer the consequences. If we are not counted in the census our state and local governments could lose federal dollars and, possibly, lose seats in the US House of Representatives. Every year, the federal government allocates more than \$400 billion to states and communities based, in part, on census data. The census data are used to determine locations for retail stores, schools, hospitals, new housing developments and other community facilities. Census data determine boundaries for state and local legislative and congressional districts. It is important that we complete the census and encourage our friends and neighbors to do the same.

That is why the LC Complete Count Committee was formed. The results of the census can dramatically affect our future. Everyone who lives in Licking County (both citizens and non citizens) must be counted. The questionnaire will be mailed to every household. Census workers will visit households that do not return the questionnaire by mail. The committee is making every effort possible to assure that everyone knows about the census and its importance to us. They also want people to know that, by law, the Census Bureau cannot share an individual's responses with anyone, including other federal agencies and enforcement entities.

The 10 item questionnaire can be completed in about 10 minutes. We have much to gain and nothing to lose by participating. The message is clear: the success of the census—and our futures—is in our hands.

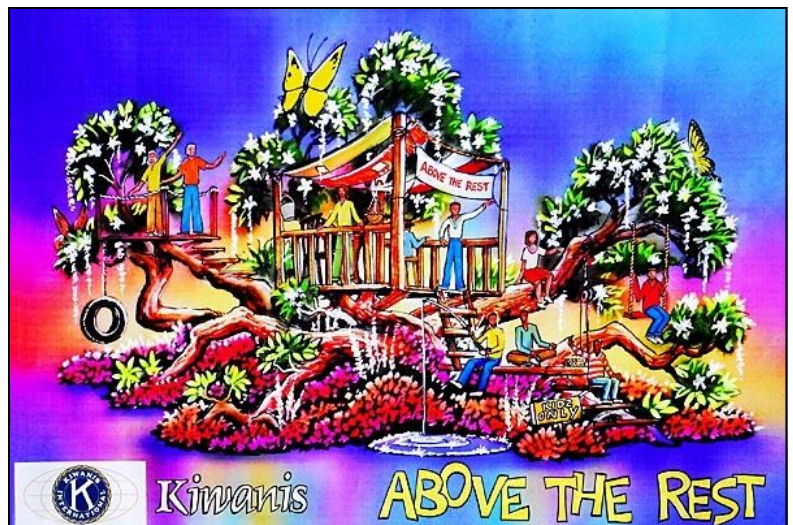


### KIWANIS AT THE TOURNAMENT OF ROSES 2010
