## Med Lab Presentation

Med Lab (Marcia Baggs and Chris Kent) presented us with a possible service project/fundraiser. They have been partnering with Kiwanis Clubs in Ohio to do a Community Health Fair. This would give people in our community that don't have health care coverage to have a complete blood work analysis for possible health issues. The public can come and ask for a specific test (those available) or they can have a complete blood work up for \$110. The average cost at a hospital or doctors office is \$600 and up. For every person that comes through the door Med Lab would pay our club \$5. They help with advertising the event and provide staff to do the testing. Possibility of also combining a breakfast and vendors to raise additional funds. If you would like more information contact Kim. FYI – Ottawa Kiwanis did their fair and netted \$16,000 for two Saturdays from 7-10 a.m. Would like to hear from members their opinions on this.....
